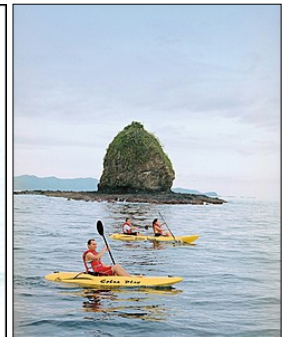

NORTH PACIFIC COAST—GUANACASTE

- ◆ **Sport Fishing**—The Chagres River and Gatun Lake
- ◆ **SCUBA** on Caribbean coast
- ◆ Panamanian Mi Pueblito venue for Final Night—outdoor plaza with old town replicas
